The Brownsville school district has allowed athletics and Fine Arts to begin face to face instruction for after school activities starting October 5th. We will use this time to prepare for football games, and to work on playing as a group in order to regain skills that haven't been used for almost six months.

Here are some things you should know:

- these rehearsals are not mandatory – participation in the after school activities will be with parent permission
- if parent permission is given, you will be expected to be at rehearsals and performances
- BISD will be providing a face mask and bell cover for the instrument. These will be used at all times.
- students will have a temperature check before each rehearsal
- social distancing guidelines will be enforced
- hand sanitizer will be available
- you will need to bring your own water and water jug
- most of the rehearsal will be OUTSIDE with the proper distance between students
- there will be no loitering at the band hall, and instruments must go home each day
- because of construction – student drop off will be on Eagle Dr. Students that drive themselves should park in the student parking lot.
- rehearsals will be from 5:00pm to 6:30pm
- we will start with a staggered schedule. Full band will resume Tuesday, Oct. 13th.
